Lyon's banking market required a place for negotiations. Impelled by Italian merchants, the Change Gallery, first Stock Exchange of Lyon was constructed in two stages:

- 1631, for the foundation,
- 1750, addition of a floor and modification of the building by Soufflot (architect of the Pantheon in Paris).
